Treatment



Braces are no longer just for youngsters. Over a million men and women are now wearing them and the numbers continue to increase. This is due to shorter treatment times and new materials that make the process more comfortable. Modern braces are far less conspicuous and now invisible, 'Incognito' braces are also available!

You need to have healthy, clean teeth before you can have any type of brace fitted.

Fixed braces

These braces are a combination of brackets and wires that are used to straighten your teeth. Treatment times can vary depending on their initial position.

Fixed braces come in a range of materials including stainless steel, gold and tooth-coloured ceramics. We can also provide coloured braces for our patients with a passion for fashion.

Removable braces

These braces must be worn all of the time and are only taken out for cleaning. They are good for solving simple problems, such as moving a single tooth, but they can also be used for complex problems, for example when the position of the jawline (in a growing patient) needs to be improved.

Clear removable aligners

We offer ClearStep and Invisalign® techniques which use a series of thin custom-made aligners that will move your teeth into a better position.

Aligners are worn on a full time basis except for eating and cleaning and for very special occasions if the need arises. Unfortunately they do not provide the best treatment for every patient and are more suited for treating milder problems.

After seeing us for an assessment your Dentist may be happy to carry out your treatment with clear aligners.

Incognito brace system

These are stuck on behind your teeth and no-one will know you are wearing them. They can be used to treat every type of orthodontic problem. Incognito braces are defining the future of orthodontic care and they allow you to have an amazing smile throughout your treatment.

National Health Service treatment

NHS treatment is available for children under 18 years of age provided that they meet specific criteria as laid down by government.

NHS appointments are only available at specific times during the week. The length of our waiting lists varies, but we anticipate that we will be able to keep waiting time down to less than 1 year between referral and commencement of treatment.

The aim of treatment provided under the NHS is to produce a healthy smile and to achieve the best possible improvement in the appearance of the teeth.

Private orthodontic treatment

Is available to adults and those children who do not qualify for NHS treatment, it is also open to children who do qualify for NHS treatment but choose not to go on our waiting list. Private treatment enables us to offer more flexibility of appointment times (evening surgery is available for instance) and longer appointments.

We can start your treatment immediately. Fees start from £60 per calendar month and we offer a variety of payment plans that will suit almost every family.

This is one investment that will make you smile.

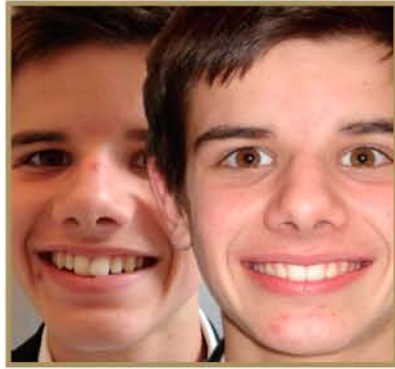
Your Dentist

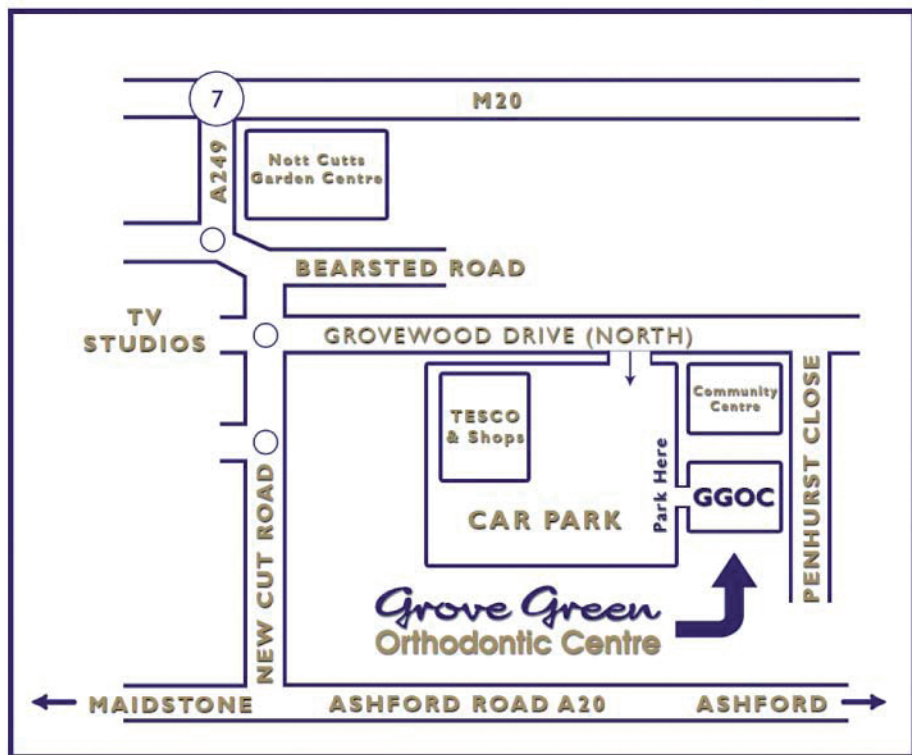
